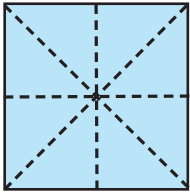
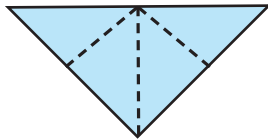


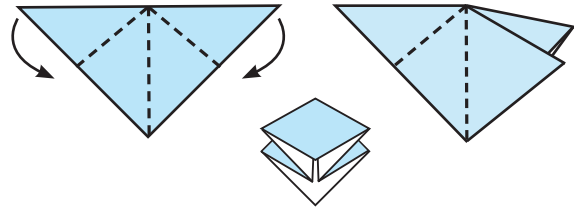
How to fold a BIRD NAPKIN



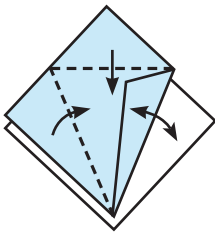
Step 1:
Start with a square piece of paper. Fold and unfold the paper so that you have the crease marks shown.



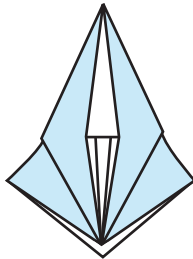
Step 2:
Fold the paper in half to make a triangle.



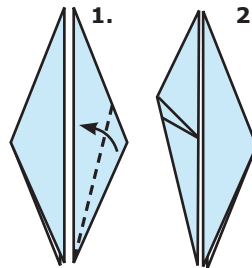
Step 3:
Tuck the left and right corners inside so that you end up with a diamond shape.



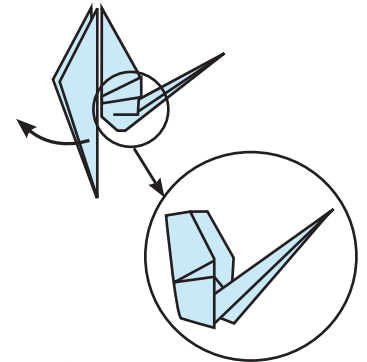
Step 4:
Point the open side toward you. Fold the uppermost flap of the paper so that you get the crease marks shown above. Unfold.



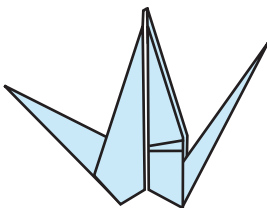
Step 5:
Open the uppermost flap by bringing the bottom corner up and pressing the side flaps in to the center. Turn the paper over, the open side toward you, and repeat steps 4-5.



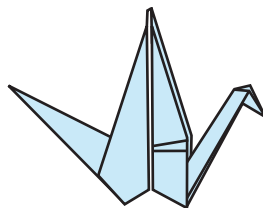
Step 6:
Make sure the separated "legs" are pointed toward you. Fold the right corner of the uppermost flap to the middle (1). Turn the paper over and repeat, but this time fold the left corner of the uppermost flap (2).



Step 7:
Lift the swan's neck (the thin "leg") out and up. Push to tuck the leg inside the two outer flaps. Then repeat with the tail (the thick "leg").



Step 8:
Your swan should now look like this. Fold down the "head" of the thinner leg.



Step 9:
Fold down the wings and your swan is finished!
