### **Our Vision**

### **The Children and Environmental Support Program**

#### **Goal of the Program**

At IKEA, children are the most important people in the world. We also believe that IKEA’s impact on the environment is significant as the world’s largest home furnishings company. Children and the environment are an important and significant social responsibility for us and each represents “the many” that can benefit from our help.

#### **Funding Guidelines**

- Within the focus areas of children and the environment, IKEA Frisco will determine where the greatest needs are for the local community.
- IKEA Frisco will only support organizations that operate in accordance with our non-discriminatory policy regarding age, race, religion, color, creed, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, citizenship, marital or veteran status, ancestry, disability or medical condition, or any other classification protected by applicable laws.
- IKEA Frisco philanthropic support excludes organizations based directly on political, religious, or professional sports affiliations.

## **How do we choose our partners?**

In order to maximize the positive impact that the program has on the lives of the children and the environment in our local communities, IKEA Frisco will focus on:

- Partnerships with organizations whose primary focus is the learning and development of children
- A few projects in our local community where we can make a real difference
- Projects where we can take an active role and utilize IKEA and our products
- Projects that are open to, and involve as many children as possible

## **When evaluating proposals we will consider the following priorities**

- Can we involve our energetic IKEA Frisco coworkers
- Is the project open to many children
- Can we use our design know-how and IKEA products
- Does the project match well with IKEA's vision
- Is the program focused on children under 18
- Is the program focused on the environment
- Is the organization registered as not for profit or a charity
- Does the project take place in one of our target communities

## **With the focus and the priorities of the Children and Environmental Support Program in mind, IKEA Frisco does not support:**

- Individual requests (requests that directly benefit one person)
- Programs which take place outside of our local store community
- Political or Religious organizations
- Third Party organizations raising funds for a charity
- Sports teams, leagues, golf tournaments
- Organizations that are not open to all members of the community
- Conferences and seminars
- Capital campaigns or purchases
- Fundraising activities including sponsorship of tables, contests, door prizes, raffles, auctions or advertising

## **How to Apply**

If you feel your organization fits within the guidelines outlined above, and you would like to submit an application for consideration, please follow these steps:

1. Fill out the Children and Environmental Support Program Application Form located below.
2. Complete all mandatory sections of the form. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. Mail the application, along with any supporting documents to IKEA Frisco.

## **What happens next?**

IKEA Frisco will review applications 3 times a year in **February, June and October only**; from this point several steps may be taken:

- The application may be turned down as it does not fit within the goals and priorities of the Children and Environmental Support Program.
- The organization may be asked to provide additional information.
- A meeting may be arranged between IKEA Frisco and your organization in order to begin a more detailed review of the proposal.
- Your application may be turned down due to the fact that we have selected our charities and are in the process of fulfilling our obligations.
- Organizations submitting proposals will receive notification of the status of their application by mail or e-mail during the months of February, June and October only.

**\*Please note:** Phone calls regarding status of your donation request will not be returned.
