

KID'S BED CURTAIN

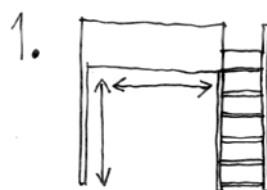
Want to make a detachable curtain for the space below a kid's loft bed?

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED

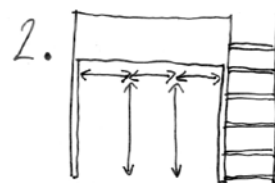
- **Measuring tape and scissors**
- **Fabric**
- **Hook-and-loop fasteners**
- **Sewing supplies**

HERE'S HOW TO DO IT

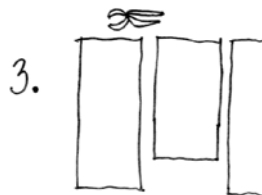
1. Measure the height and width of the space below the loft bed.



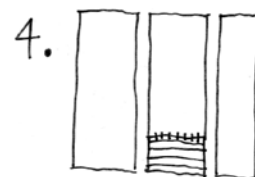
2. Determine where you want the roll-up door. Take these measurements. Leave 1 cm for the curtain's hem.



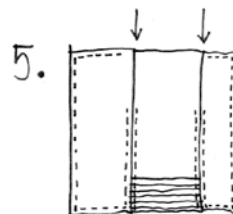
3. Cut the fabric into three sections. We chose to have a different patterned fabric on the bottom of the door, which is why we made the middle section shorter.



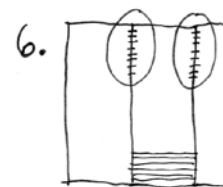
4. Measure and cut the fabric you have chosen for the bottom of the door. Sew it onto the middle section so that all three sections are the same length.



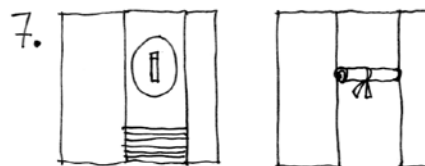
5. Hem all of the sides except where you will sew the pieces together.



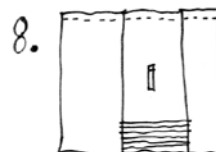
6. Sew together the sides at the top. Stop where you will have the door.



7. Sew a strip of fabric onto the inside and outside of the door. This will be the tie to hold the door open.



8. Sew hook-and-loop fasteners along the top of the curtain. (This makes it detach easily and safely.) Attach hook-and-loop fasteners to the bed.



9. Get cosy!
