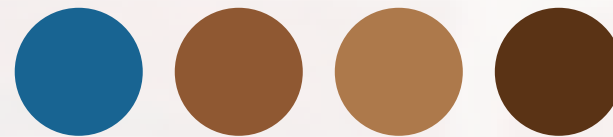

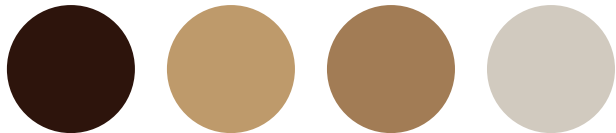

This style expression is all about capturing the softness and simplicity of neutrals, highlighting quality, crafted, tactile products, and celebrating traditional elegance.

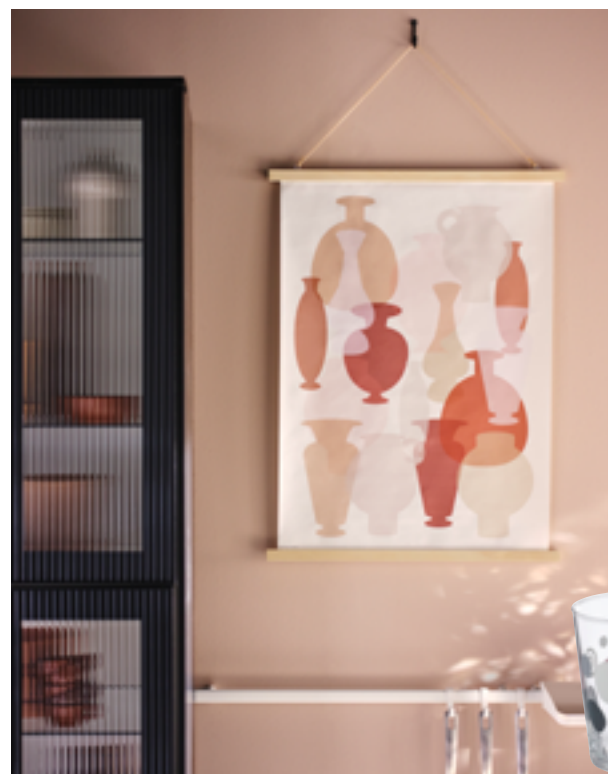

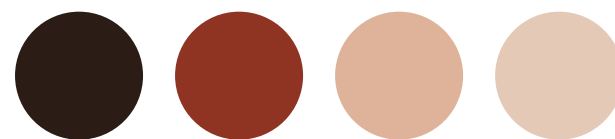
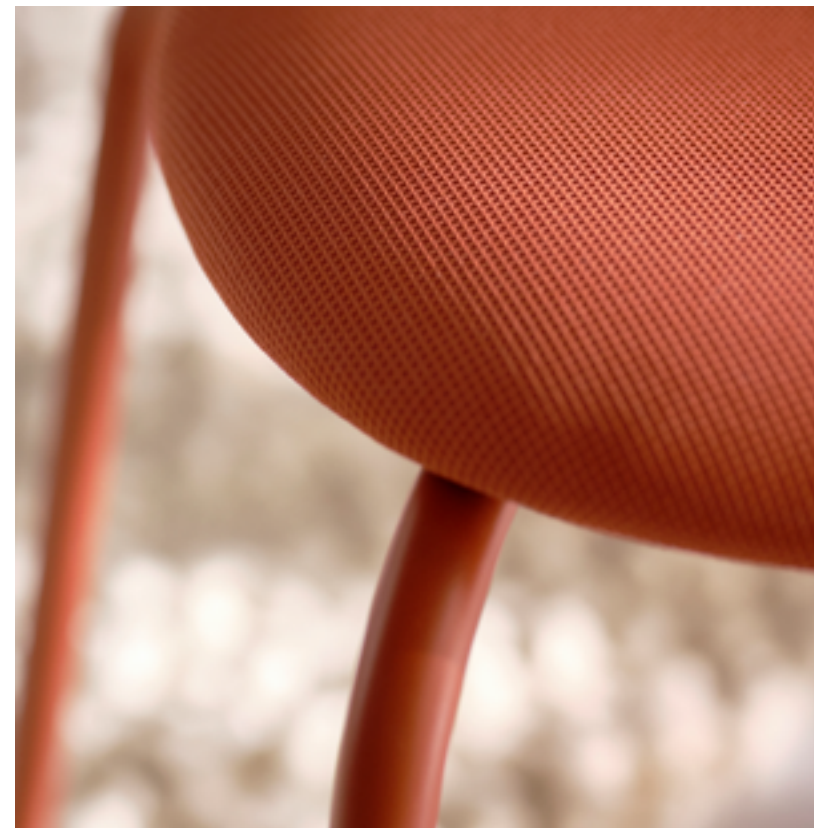
Bring summer into the kitchen

The sleek and stylish matte black kitchen is easy to personalise and combine with a couple of white wall cabinets and light pink wall tiles, so the feeling is airy and modern.

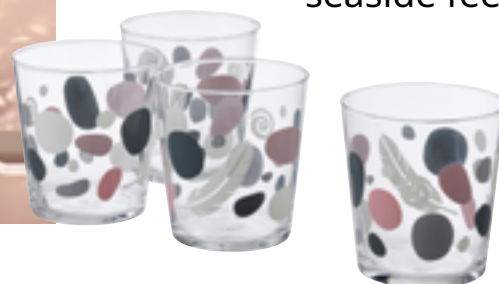

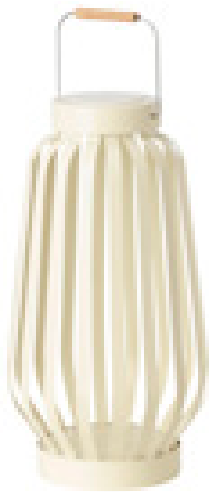
