Akanksha Deo is a designer and visual artist who combines Indian textile history and techniques to create clean and playful outcomes. Several of her products for IKEA have been made in close collaboration with Indian artisans, using a combination of traditional and modern techniques.

Akanksha, born and raised in New Delhi, India, was drawn to art from an early age. After missing the deadlines to art school, she turned to design and fashion. And it was during a workshop at her university, the National Institute of Fashion Technology, NIFT, that she first encountered IKEA.

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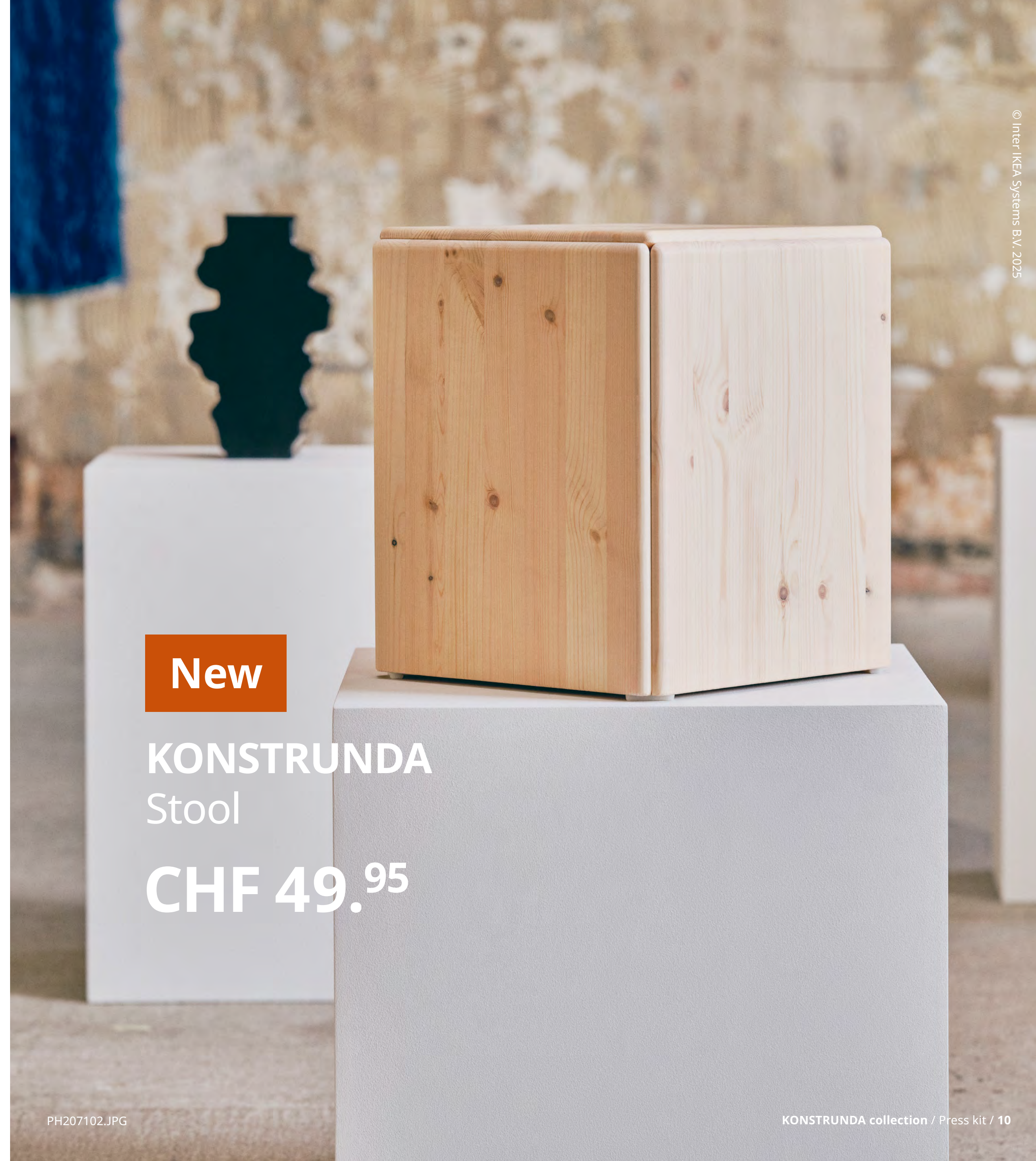

A rationalistic approach that leaves room for wonder is their driving force.

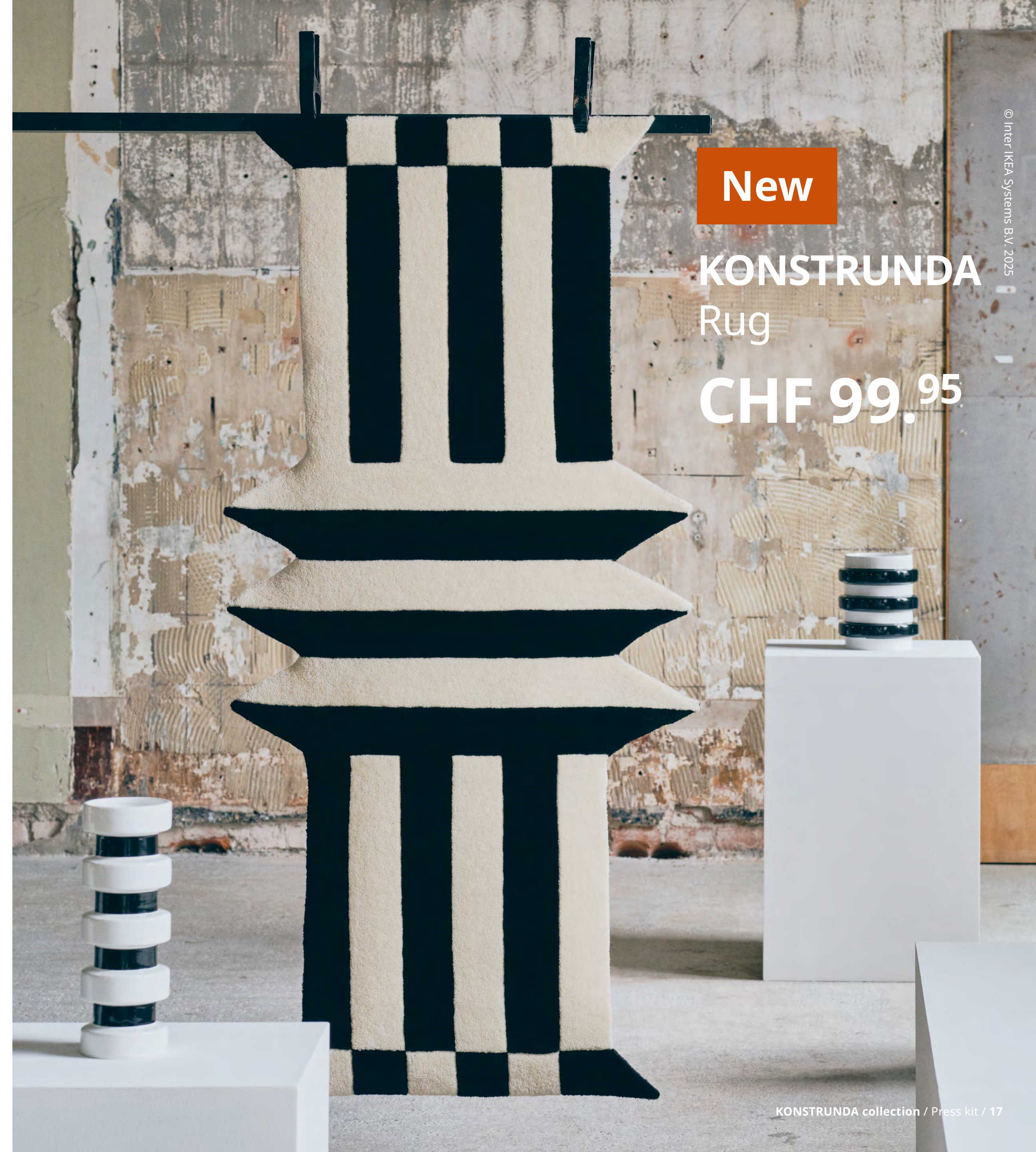

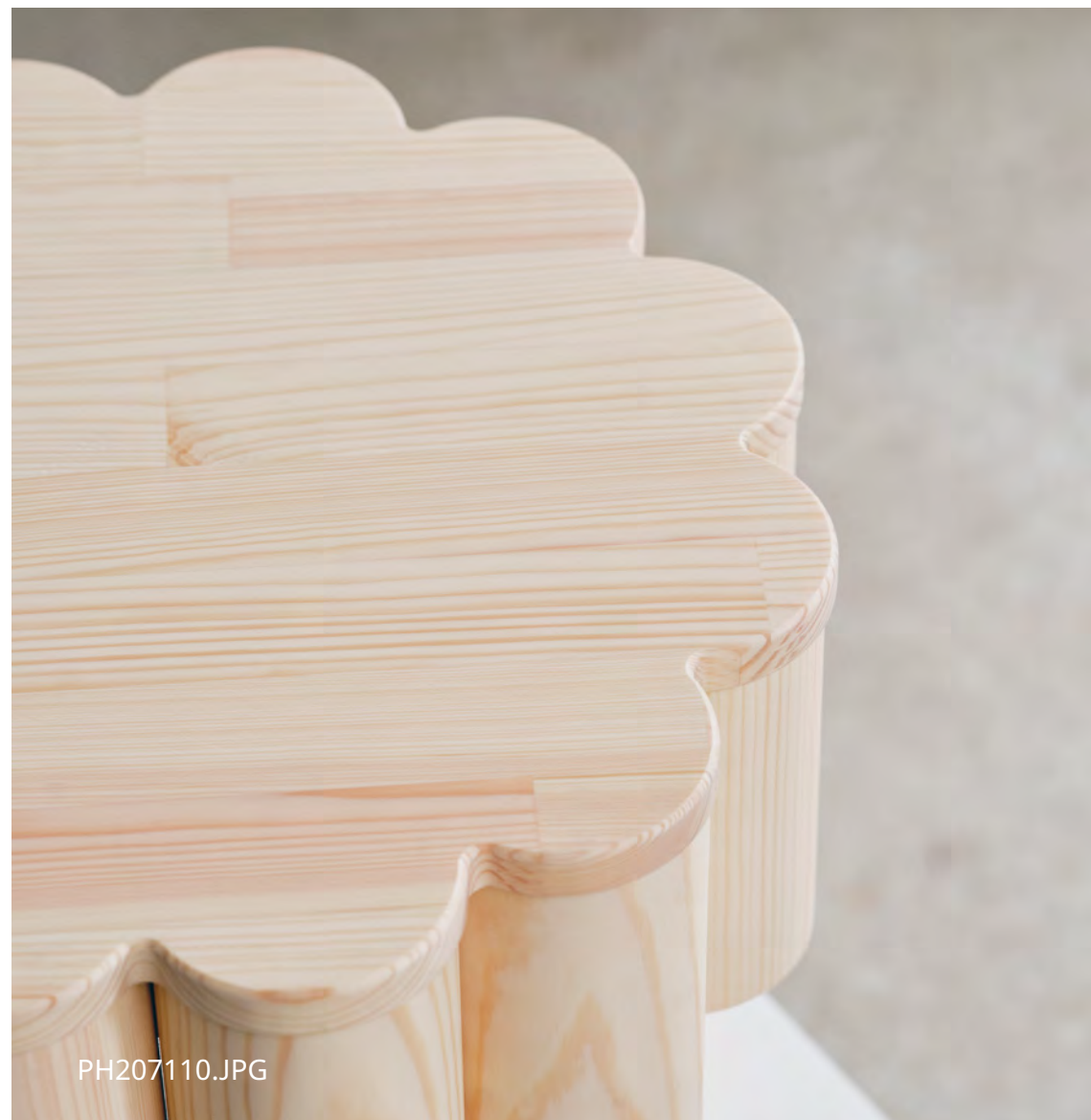
Lisa Hilland
