



Lace dreamcatcher

1. Print or draw the templates on harder paper, it can be coloured. You can also draw circles by tracing around the edges of cups or plates. It is better to choose smaller diameters for this type of dreamcatcher. You will need several identical pairs. One larger pair of circles and several smaller pairs.
2. From an older lace curtain, cut out rounds the same size (or a little smaller) as the paper circles, one lace round for each pair of circles.
3. Glue the lace between two identical paper circles and let it dry.
4. Decorate the largest paper circle with ornaments in the shape of clouds, stars or whatever you can think of.
5. Join the smaller circles with lace together with thread or ribbon in three strips. Attach these strips to the bottom edge of the large circle with lace.
6. On the top of the large circle, make an eyelet hole, insert a piece of thread or ribbon and hang your beautiful trap on the wall or above your bed. Now you can go to sleep.
