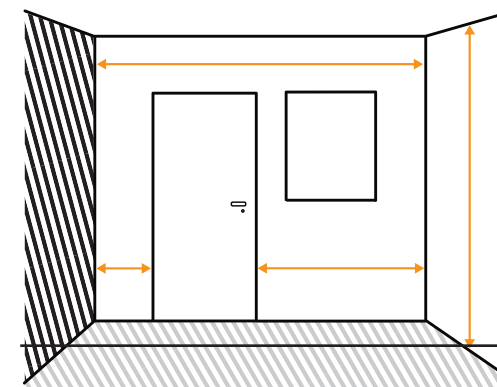
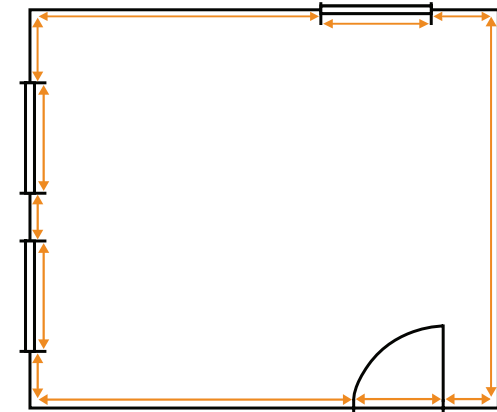

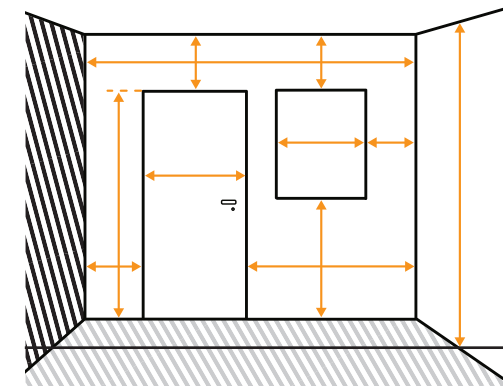

Measure with precision

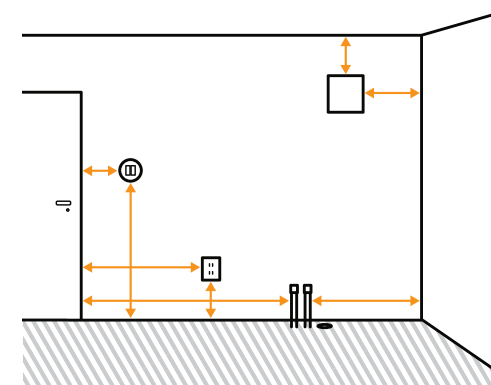
Measuring your space isn't hard, but it is important all measurements are accurate as this will be the foundations of your project. Take your time when taking measurements. It's best if the measurements are taken in **millimeters** as this ensures accuracy.



01 Start by measuring the distance between the floor and the ceiling, and between and corners and doors.



02 Measure the windows and their distance to the floor, ceiling and corners. As well as their height and width.



03 If you've any furniture you'd like to keep, we'd also need the measurements of those, as well as any radiators, TVs etc and their location. We also ask that you locate light sources and switches. If you have any technical drawings of your space, please send them on.
