

We provide all this while making sure it doesn't cost the earth or your wallet, since sleep is essential for your health. So yes, we know a thing or two about mattresses and all the other things you need for a good night's sleep.



A great day starts with a good nights sleep

If you wake up feeling refreshed you know you've found the right mattress. It can be a little daunting, so we'll guide you through some key points to help you. When you get the right balance of support and firmness, it just feels right. This is because your spine is in its natural alignment and the mattress supports your body weight, sleeping position and body shape – so your body can relax for restful and calm sleep.







A well-balanced mattress provides support where needed, allowing heavier body parts to sink into the mattress, not too much or too little.

The mattress moulds itself to your body with little or no gaps between you and the mattress. The spine enjoys a natural and comfy alignment, helping you to relax – and sleep soundly.





Too firm – too much pressure on the body

A mattress is too firm when you feel as if you lie on top of it.

Shoulders and hips don't sink into the mattress, it doesn't mould itself to your body and you may find gaps between your body and the mattress, causing an unbalanced feel. This increases pressure on the body, and the spine doesn't align correctly, causing disrupted sleep.





Too soft – no support for the body

A mattress is too soft when the feeling is that the entire body sinks into it without support for shoulders and hips.

The spine doesn't align correctly, and it can be difficult to change sleeping position. This means the muscles have to work to get comfortable as you sleep, making it difficult to relax fully, and you'll wake up not feeling refreshed.


Better spine alignment with comfort zones

What are comfort zones?

A mattress with comfort zones will have different levels of firmness in different parts of the mattress. Comfort zones are beneficial to some since they are designed to provide targeted support and pressure relief to different parts of your body as you sleep.

What is good spine alignmnet?

Good alignment when lying down is that your spine is similar in posture as when standing, a straight and natural position that does not feel forced or uncomfortable



Our engineers and comfort lab have designed mattresses based on data from sleep simulations to create targeted areas that support the body in a good way for spine alignment and relaxed sleep.

Generally softer areas around the heavier parts of the body (hips and shoulders) to enable them to sink into the mattress optimally. Shoulders can sink in as much as they need while the weight of the hips is distributed better. Firmer areas where the body is lighter will keep the mattress close to the body, helping to promote healthy spine alignment.



How to choose your mattress

There is no need to be an expert when choosing the right mattress, we're all for making things easy. Look for a mattress that supports your body and keeps the spine in its natural position, similar to when you stand

Three characteristics to consider are body weight, sleeping position and body shape. Learning a little more about these will help guide you to the right mat-

Body weight

When choosing the right mattress, body weight can affect the level of support and comfort that you need. Take a look at the table to the right to get an understanding of which firmness matches your body weight.

Sleeping position

Your sleeping position can also affect the type of mattress that's right for you. Different positions place different amounts of pressure on the body, and this can affect the type of mat-

tress and pillow that is right for you. Read more below about different sleeping positions.




Sleeping on your back

Generally, a mattress without comfort zones benefits back sleepers, promoting freedom of movement and a natural spine alignment.

A mattress with comfort zones can be beneficial for heavier back sleepers. A softer mattress is more suitable for those with lighter body weight.

You'll need the support of a firmer pillow when sleeping on your back



Sleeping on your side

A mattress with comfort zones that allow hips and shoulders to sink in more while the rest of the body is supported is ideal.

Generally, a softer mattress is a good choice, but for heavier body weights, a firmer one can be more suitable.

A higher/firmer pillow helps to keep the neck and spine aligned when sleeping on your side.




Sleeping on your stomach


A firmer mattress that helps the spine maintain its natural shape and reduce pressure on the spine (no banana shape) as much as possible is ideal.

A low pillow or no pillow is preferred to secure head and spine alignment for a stomach sleeper

Body shape

Narrow hips, wide shoulders or narrow hips and shoulders? We're all different, and it's important to keep this in mind when choosing a mattress that supports your body shape. Read more below.

Generally, for those with wider hips and/or shoulders, a mattress with comfort zones is recommended. For those with a narrower body type most mattresses are suitable

Personal preference & needs

Temperature regulation:

For those who prefer a cooler sleeping environment, spring mattresses allow air to flow, and latex is made with holes to help air movement. High-resilience foam has more of an "on top" feel, potentially providing a cooler experience. Also look for cooling mattresses or mattress pads, they have a special layer that stays cooler as you drift off to sleep.

For those who prefer warmer sleep environment, foam mattresses or pads are generally warmer, as air flow is more restricted. A thicker duvet will also keep the heat in.

Discomfort:

If you experience pain or discomfort, especially in your back or neck, you may need a mattress with specific support in those areas. A mattress with comfort zones supports the body and helps it to relax more, depending on the body type. Don't forget that a pillow can support your neck too.

A mattress pad is a good way of customising comfort needs, both memory foam and latex are good for reducing tension in muscles, helping them to relax.

If you don't move much during sleep but have discomfort, memory foam is a good choice. If you move around during sleep but feel discomfort, latex, plush foam and high resilience foam are good options.

Calm or active sleep:

Most of us move around during sleep, if it's either a little (calm sleepers), or a lot (active sleepers) we have materials that will allow you to move without waking up

Calm sleepers will benefit from memory foam as it hugs you as you sleep and responds slowly and consistently to your

Latex, high resilience foam, plush foam and standard foam are more responsive to movement, making them ideal for active sleepers.

We have different pillow materials to choose from such as polyester, natural and ergonomic pillows. Also, if you often feel warm while sleeping then choose a pillow with a cooling function which can add that extra comfort to your sleeping environment.

Duvets

The complete sleep experience

Six ways to enjoy better sleep

Tired and slow or alert and energised. Good or poor sleep makes all the difference to a day. How long people need to sleep varies, but deep undisturbed sleep is always invigorating. Here are six things to keep in mind to enjoy better sleep.



Comfort

It should of course feel comfy to crawl into bed. The trick is to have the right duvet, a mattress that suits you and your way of sleeping and a pillow that helps you find a good position. And then it's good night sleep tight!

Temperature

A cool bedroom is almost always best, around 16–17C $^{\circ}$ is usually the recommendation. Also remember to choose a duvet that suits the season and the temperature you are most comfortable with.

Sound

Loud, sudden or other disturbing noises affect sleep negatively. In a perfect world, it's absolute silent where you sleep, but it's also possible to dampen the sound with things like soft furniture, hefty curtains and thick carpets.

Air quality

Good air quality is even more important in the bedroom than in other rooms, since we spend a lot of time in bed. A fan, air purifier or air conditioner makes a big difference, but green plants can also have a positive effect on air quality.

Light

As dark as possible, that's the obvious recommendation. Blackout curtains keep out both sunlight and city lights, otherwise an eye mask will help. Before going to sleep, warm dimmed light is best, as it prepares the brain for sleep.

Home furnishing and decluttering

Calm colours like blue, green and yellow are preferred in the bedroom. Keep the decor simple and try to organise your things so the bedroom doesn't feel cluttered. The less clutter, the more likely it is that you will sleep well.

Our mattresses

For over 50 years our teams have been designing mattresses. We use our in-house comfort lab and knowledge from our development partners to create mattresses for different body types – to help you get a good night's sleep. There are several different materials we use, and we'll describe some of their features.

Mattress firmness

It's important to note that the firmness level of a mattress can be subjective, meaning that what one person considers medium firm, another may find too soft or too firm. To determine which firmness level you prefer, it's recommended to try out different mattresses and gauge your comfort level.

A medium-firm mattress is a very weight-sensitive mattress that can follow the body's shape to give support in different sleeping positions and for cer-A firm mattress is suitable for mid to heavier weight sleepers. It supports by

following the natural shape of the body while allowing free movement

Even when you've found the right mattress, you may find it can take a few weeks for the body and mattress to adjust properly. If there are no health issues to consider, you should wake feeling refreshed and without pain.

Spring mattresses

We have two types of spring mattresses, Bonnell and pocket. Spring mattresses are durable and distribute your weight evenly.

Bonnell springs are an open construction that helps air flow through the mattress and gives a uniform feel as all the springs are joined to each other. Also, movement can transfer – ideal for single person sleep. Pocket springs are springs in individual pockets that move and respond independently so movement is not transferred through the mattress, meaning partners movements won't disturb you as you sleep.

All spring mattresses have a layer of foam on top that optimises support and comfort thanks to the spring construction.

Foam mattresses

Foam mattresses provide support and distribute your weight. Different foams support the body in different ways, memory foam helps relieve pressure, plush foam has a nice sink-in effect and high-resilience foam gives a more sleep on the top feeling.

We combine different foams in some mattresses for comfort and support. For example, a high-resilience foam base provides support, when topped with memory foam you'll benefit from pressure relieving properties.

Foam mattresses are temperature sensitive, meaning if the room temperature is cooler then the foam can feel firmer.

Combined with a bed frame, slatted bed-bases can be used as a base for spring, foam and latex mattresses. They help your mattress last longer and stay comfortable

by absorbing most of the stress and weight placed on your bed. You can adjust the slats in some bases to be more or less firm, and some can be adjusted at the foot and head, allowing you to sit up and read or watch television or keep your legs elevated. Curved and flat slats can give a different comfort feeling.

How to choose duvets, pillows and protectors

Duvets, pillows and protectors are an important part of the complete sleep comfort. The pillow that feels best for you together with your favorite mattress is the base for a good night sleep. Adding a pillow and a mattress protector to protect and keep the pillow and mattress fresh and prolong its life is easy to be done. A duvet in your preferred material and warmth rate is the last element which makes you feel comfy in bed, sleep well and wake up refreshed.

In order to find the right duvet or pillow for you, it is good to consider the following:

1. Natural or man-made filling material?

We offer a wide choice of duvets and pillows in different material choices: Natural materials like down and feathers and man-made materials like polyester, lyocell and memory foam. Considering which material is best for your comfort needs will help you to narrow down your choice considerably. Read more about the filling materials on the following pages.

2. Which quality?

We have duvets and pillows in different qualities to fit individual needs and budgets. These qualities are determined by the materials they are made of and the detail of workmanship. For sure, no matter your choice, they are all designed to give you the best possible comfort.

3. A cooler or a warmer duvet?

The duvet that is just right for you is determined by your sleeping preferences. Do you easily get warm in bed or do you rather need more warmth from your duvet? Do you share the duvet with someone? What's your bedroom's temperature? For children, it's best to choose a duvet that's cooler and rather lightweight, breathes well and is easy to wash, preferably duvets in man-made material. You can find duvets for younger children at Children's IKEA.

4. A softer or a firmer pillow?

We offer pillows in a softer and a firmer comfort. It is a good start to test your pillow together with your mattress in order to find the right one for you. Small children are most comfortable with softer pillows. For older children, it's best to choose a pillow according to their individual preferences. You can find pillows for younger children at Children's IKEA. Adding on a pillow protector is an easy way to keep your pillow clean and fresh so it lasts longer.

Duvets and pillows comfort symbols

The symbols below are used to show the features of our comfort products.



Cool

This is a cool, very thin and lightweight duvet with less filling. It contains a temperature-regulating material.



Light warm

This is light warm, thin and a lightweight duvet wit less filling.



Warm

This is a warm, thicker duvet with more filling.

This is an extra warm, really thick duvet with a generous amount of filling.

How to care for your duvets and pillows

General advice for all materials

Mites thrive in damp, warm and dark environments. Therefore, when you wake up in the morning, air your duvets and pillows well so remaining moisture can evaporate before putting them back on the bed. Moreover, you can wash all IKEA duvets and pillows at 60°C (apart from memory foam pillows, where only the cover can be washed), the temperature at which mites die. To keep your duvets and pillows free from mites

and dirt, carefully follow the washing instructions. Air your duvets and pillows often so they will be free from dust and stay fresh and dry.

You can prolong the life of your pillows with a pillow protector which protects them from stains and dirt, read more on page 68.

Natural material

- For down and feather duvets and pillows you should only use one third of the normal amount of detergent and wash them separately.
- After washing, dry your natural duvets and pillows in the tumble dryer without delay until the filling is completely dry. You can place some tennis balls in the dryer which will keep the filling moving and ensure more efficient drying. Like that your duvets and pillows will regain their fluffiness and dry more quickly. The balls should of course not shed colour.

Man-made material

• Man-made duvets and pillows are very easy to care for and can be washed often. They also dry relatively quickly.

Memory foam

- · A pillow with memory foam filling moulds to your head and neck. This helps your muscles relax and, consequently, you will move less and sleep better.
