

## More Sustainable Sources (MSS) requirements for paper and wood content products

All paper and wood-based products must be either recycled or FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) certified according to following definitions:

- FSC 100%
- FSC Mix 70-100%
- FSC Mix Credit
- FSC Recycled 100%
- FSC Recycled Credit

As a producer of wood or paper products for Ingka Supplier **must** hold a valid FSC chain of custody certificate and sell all products to Ingka as FSC certified. If the FSC Chain of Custody certificate is revoked or suspended, Ingka must be informed immediately in writing.

As a supplier purchasing finished wood or paper-based products for Ingka the product **must** be FSC certified and carry the FSC logo on the product or the packaging.

When using Recycled paper/wood for Ingka products the Supplier **must** verify the 100% recycle status through a self-declaration from the producer and provide this to Ingka prior to any delivery.

Supplier agrees that products/components/raw materials from APP<sup>1</sup> /APRIL<sup>2</sup> suppliers are not part of the products produced and supplied to Ingka, including packaging and other wood/paper-based materials.

When requested by Ingka, the Supplier **must** provide information on paper/wood usage of Ingka products. This information shall, at a minimum, include tons used, what FSC certification the paper holds, paper type and paper supplier. Supplier agrees to verification activities of this information.
