**Preventing furniture
tip-over accidents**



WALL ANCHORING GUIDE

The hardware used to secure your furniture to the wall depends on your wall material. If your wall material is not listed or if you have questions, consult your local hardware retailer.

WALL MATERIAL

Plasterboard with available wood stud

ANCHORING DEVICE

Screw inserted directly into stud. For example, a 5 mm wood screw provided with IKEA FIXA plug and screw set.

WALL MATERIAL

Plasterboard without available wood stud

ANCHORING DEVICE

Plug with screw. For example, an 8 mm plug provided with IKEA FIXA plug and screw set.

WALL MATERIAL

Masonry

ANCHORING DEVICE

Solid masonry wall: Plug with screw. For example, an 8 mm plug provided with IKEA FIXA plug and screw set.

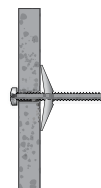
