

IKEA Tempe Textiles Take-back Terms & Conditions

In collaboration with RSPCA NSW, IKEA Tempe will be launching a home textiles take-back where customers can bring in their old bedding, towels and blankets which will be donated to RSPCA NSW to be used as bedding for animals in shelters.

These terms and conditions are in addition to, and do not affect, the IKEA Returns Policy or your statutory rights under the Competition and Consumer Act 2010.

How does it work?

At IKEA we believe our products deserve a second life, and as such we are willing (on behalf of RSPCA NSW) to accept donations of used textiles products.

Products being accepted for the Textiles Take-back include:

- Blankets
- Towels
- Sheets
- Quilt covers

To be eligible for our Textiles Take-back, products must:

- be washed and clean
- be of acceptable quality and fit the purpose

IKEA will donate all accepted textiles to RSPCA NSW.

Is there anything IKEA is unable to accept?

The following categories of products are not eligible for the Textiles Take-back:

- Bean bags
- Quilts
- Pillows
- Pillowcases

Where is the textiles take-back service happening?

The IKEA Textiles Take-back is only at the IKEA Tempe store.

Textiles are able to be donated in the area after the cash line near the store exit- where customers are also able to recycle other items including light globes and batteries.

When is the Take-back service happening?

The IKEA Tempe Textiles Take-back will run from the 06/07/2019 to 14/07/2019. IKEA will not be accepting any textile donations prior to, or following these dates. IKEA reserves the right to end the program at any time.

Why wasn't my product accepted?

IKEA reserves the right to refuse to accept a product at its sole discretion, including if your products are ineligible for the Textiles Take-back.
