
Living room storage system

Good to know

Tempered glass should be handled with care! A damaged edge or a scratched surface can cause the glass to break suddenly. Avoid bumps from the side – this is where the glass is most vulnerable.



You can also use the planner to design your own unique BESTÅ combination from scratch.


Start with thinking about the function, what will the storage be used for? Do you need doors or drawers? And how much space do you have?



Frames

Width×Depth×Height. You need a suspension rail to be able to wall mount BESTÅ frames. Floor-standing furniture must be secured to the wall with the enclosed wall fastener. Different wall materials require different types of fixing devices. Use fixing devices suitable for the walls in your home, sold separately.

How to mount a frame on the wall

You will need a suspension rail to mount BESTÅ frames on a wall. The suspension rail works as a reinforcement and makes it both easier and safer to mount the BESTÅ frame to the wall. The rail screws into the wall studs and has many holes so there's always a hole over a stud.

You can easily hang several frames next to each other and align them at exactly the same height thanks to the included connector. Ensure that you have a minimum of 5 cm between the top of the frame and the ceiling. This is needed to be able to mount the frame to the suspension rail.



BESTÅ suspension rail, silver-colour. 60 cm wide frames require 1 BESTÅ suspension rail. 120 cm wide frames require 2 BESTÅ suspension rails. The suspension rail cannot be used with BESTÅ TV benches. BESTÅ suspension rail is included in all wall-mounted combinations.

Frames for TV benches

Width×Depth×Height. Floor-standing furniture must be secured to the wall with the enclosed wall fastener. Different wall materials require different types of fixing devices. Use fixing devices suitable for the walls in your home, sold separately.

How to mount a TV bench on the wall

Fittings for wall mounting are included in the package. In order to hang your TV bench on the wall simply follow the assembly instructions.

Fixing devices for the wall are not included since different wall materials require different types of fixing devices. Use fixing devices suitable for the walls in your home.

For advice on suitable fixing systems, contact your local specialized dealer.

NOTE! Fittings for wall mounting are included in the package.

BESTÅ legs

BESTÅ legs raise your BESTÅ combination from the floor, giving a light, airy look and making it easy to clean the floor underneath.

60 cm wide frames require 4 legs.

120 cm wide frames require 5 legs or 4 legs and one BESTÅ supporting leg.

120 cm wide TV benches require 6 legs or 4 legs and one BESTÅ supporting leg.
180 cm wide TV benches require 8 legs or 4 legs and 2 BESTÅ supporting legs

How to choose integrated lighting

Start by choosing a plug-in or battery-operated light.

TVÄRDRAG/YTBERG are cabinet lights designed for placement on top of the wardrobe. This type of light helps you highlight items on top of the shelves or in open corner furniture.

Plug-in products always need to be completed with a driver. Plug-in complete solutions can also be connected to IKEA Smart lighting by using the DIRIGERA hub.


KÖLVATTEN is a battery-operated LED light strip, which is easy to install since no cables are needed. KÖLVATTEN LED light is sensor activated and should be placed inside a cabinet.

How to choose a driver

There are two different versions of drivers, with different functions; for an on/off solution you can use ANSLUTA, and TRÅDFRI for more functions.

For TRÅDFRI there are 2 versions:
10W to connect a total of 3 units, if maximum wattage does not exceed 10W
30W LED to connect/ support up to 9 units, max. wattage 30W.
A flashing light indicates the maximum wattage of the LED driver is exceeded.




