
Good to know about the pull-out wardrobe

In the pull-out lower part of the wardrobe, your child has a full overview and can reach hooks and drawers from two sides. The hooks make it easy to both take down and hang clothes and other belongings up again. In the upper part you can store clothes and other things that are not used every day.



- 1. At the top there is a fixed drawer with space for all the small things that easily get displaced.
- 2. The hinges have built-in dampers so that the doors close softly and do not risk jamming any fingers.
- 3. Hooks on the inside and outside make it easier for your child to hang up clothes, backpacks and other things off the floor.
- 4. The high edges of the bottom are used to strengthen the structure, while also creating a storage box.
- 5. It hurts to hit a sharp edge. That's why the corners of all doors and drawers in SMÅSTAD are softly rounded.
- With symbols in HÄNGIG label holder, it will be easier for both children and adults to organize the insides of drawers and wardrobes.
