On April 17, 2024, IKEA U.S will issue a press release announcing that all IKEA chests and dressers sold in the U.S. meet the new mandatory furniture stability standards as established through passage of the Stop Tip-overs of Unstable, Risky Dressers on Youth (STURDY) Act in 2022.

Stability solutions for chests and dressers



Added Weight and Design

• A solution that is based on adding or redistributing weight and how we design the product to counteract the tip-over risk, like a forward-extended base, or added feet.

Wall mounted

• A solution that must be mounted to the wall to stand up straight on the floor. It has simple support points instead of traditional feet – since it always needs support from the wall to stand upright.

Shortened Drawer Extension

This solution reduces the drawer extension to counteract the tip-over risk.

Drawer Interlock solution

• The drawer interlock in this chest of drawers means that only one drawer can be opened at a time.

Anchor and Unlock solution


• The Anchor and Unlock solution prevents all drawers from being opened, until anchored to the wall. Once anchored, all drawers may be opened at once.

To communicate to our customers the clothing storage furniture products that meet the Federal Stability Standard, we've created an icon with text that will appear on these products on all customer touchpoints.



Designed to meet the US Federal Stability Standard

On April 19, 2023, the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) voted to adopt ASTM F2057-23 as a mandatory federal safety standard for dressers and other clothing storage furniture. The standard was designed to help reduce the risk of tip-over accidents and sets performance requirements for clothing storage furniture.

When you see this symbol, you'll know that IKEA clothing storage furniture is designed and tested to meet the new federal safety standard.




