# Sliding door system

#### Safety

This furniture must be fixed to the ceiling. Different ceiling materials require different types of fixing devices. Use fixing devices suitable for the ceilings in your home, sold separately.

Clean the floor rail and door wheels regularly to make sure the doors run smoothly and the wheels are not damaged.

#### **Assembly**


The total assembly height including the floor and ceiling rails is 80½" for the 77%" door, and 94%" for the 91" door. They can both be adjusted %" up or down.

#### Service message

Installing sliding doors can require professional carpentry knowledge.

### Good to know

Create your own sliding door by choosing between different frames and panels – and combine them as you like.

Our wide range of panels lets you choose between various materials and expressions, such as semi-transparent, glass, high-gloss, wooden foil and mirror.

Integrated handles give the sliding doors a sleek look with clean lines

If your ceiling is higher than the doors, you can use SKYTTA ceiling height reducer and cover panel to create a fake wall and fill the gap up to 14" above the doors.

If the doors are higher than then your ceiling, it's possible to cut the door at the top, along with the panel. We recommend that you always use our Assembly services for this.


When installing your new storage solution and SKYTTA doors, make sure there are no cables, pipes or heating systems nearby that may prevent the doors from closing completely or which might get damaged during installation



### Plan on paper or use the planner tool


Planning your SKYTTA sliding doors can be a bit tricky, and it's important that all the measurements are correct and aligned. It's perfectly fine to plan on paper if that's what you prefer, but there's also a planner tool available on IKEA-USA.com/planner to help you out!

# How to measure your space




Measure the width (1,2) and height (A, B, C) of your space. Make sure to measure the height in at least three places as the ceiling or floor might be slightly uneven. It's important that you measure the exact spot where you are going to place your doors, and

that each surface is straight. Uneven or angled surfaces needs to be adjusted before the doors are installed, for example if you are placing SKYTTA sliding doors against a sloped ceiling.




Don't forget about the skirting board or crown molding. We recommend to always remove or cut them, or there will be a gap between the door and wall. It's also possible to use a stop bar, explained more on page 9.

# How to plan - sloped ceiling


SKYTTA ceiling rail must be mounted onto a flat surface which is parallell with the floor. It cannot be mounted directly onto a sloped ceiling.

If you want to install SKYTTA sliding doors onto a sloped ceiling, you need to add an extra piece of wall which is wider than the width of the rail, and which creates a 90 degree angle with the wall.



# **How to plan – SKYTTA height**

Our doors come in two heights but even if your height is a little bit lower, or a lot higher, there's a solution for you.



Height	Height	Problem	Solution
82%-94%"	96½-108¾"	A lot of space left above the doors Compensate the ceiling height with SKYTTA ceiling height reducer and cover panels, or contact a carpenter for a customized solution. See more on page 10.	
80¾-82%"	94%-98%"	Just a little space left above the doors Compensate the ceiling height with distance pieces toward the ceiling. Not sold by IKEA.	
801/4-803/4"	94%-94%"	The door fits perfectly!  Normal assembly woth doors and rails. The rails add %" to the height of the door and are able to adjust +/- ¼".	
39%-40%"	39%-94%"	The doors are too high It's possible to cut the door and panels. Please note that this option is not applicable for glass or mirror glass panels, as the glass is tempered and will split into tiny pieces. This step needs to be done by a professional carpenter with the appropriate tools.	

# How to plan - SKYTTA total width

You can choose between two widths of doors. They are placed next to each other with a slight overlap so that there will not be any gap between them. That's why you need to count on a width that's slightly smaller than the door.

#### The formula to use is as follows:

30%" × number of 40%" wide doors


- + 28¾" × number of 30%" wide doors
- + 1%" = the total width of the solution.

The extra 1%" is to compensate for the fact that there's not any overlap in the ends of the solution. Here's a table of the most common combinations and their total width already counted.


These widths are counted with the recommended overlap. But if your space is just a little narrower it's of course possible to have a bit more overlap, or less if that's the case. Just remember that a big overlap will show through the doors if you choose glass panels.





# How to plan - storage behind

When you are placing storage behind your SKYTTA sliding door it's important to plan for that so that you are able to reach and/ or open everything.

As an example, a drawer should not be placed behind the overlap of a door unless both doors can be moved, or the drawer cannot be opened.




# How to choose color and panels

The SKYTTA sliding door frames comes in white, aluminum and black and you can combine them with all the panels from the PAX range. Either go with a matched solution or create a strong impact with contrasting finishes, it's all up to you!

The panels are sold in a package of four, so for each SKYTTA door you choose, you also need one package of panels. There's a wide variety of colors, materials and finishes to choose from and you can mix them any way you like.

Just keep in mind that some of the panels have a different color or finish on the backside, something that might be good to know if you are planning a solution where you see the doors from both sides.




## **SKYTTA rails and fittings**

### Pick the right amount of rails

When you have decided on the amount of doors, you pick the rails. Each rail is 78¾" long and can be joint and then cut to the correct length to match the width of the doors. They are available in the same finishes as the door frames – white, aluminum and black.

The rails come in two versions, a 2-track and a 3-track. If you have chosen three doors, we recommend using the 3-track rail so that it's possible to slide all the three doors behind each other and get an opening as big as possible.

If you have chosen two, four or more doors, we recommend using the 2-track rails.

# And the right amount of fittings for the doors

Depending on the rail, you always pick one package of fitting for either 2-track or 3-track rails. They are used for the two doors in the ends. If you have two doors, this is all you need. If you have chosen more than two doors, you also need one package of fittings for middle door per each extra door. Here's a table to help you figure out how many packages of fittings you will need.


### How to plan - total depth


#### Get the right depth

Since SKYTTA runs on rails from floor to ceiling, you can pick and choose what storage solution you want to place behind the doors.

Don't forget to add enough space for your storage, as well as the depth of the rails and some extra space. We are suggesting a minimum of 1%" between the sliding doors and the storage behind them.

Please note that the ceiling rail is a little deeper than the floor rail, due to the cover parts, as shown in the illustration. For the 2-track rail you need to count 3¼" depth, and for the 3-track rail you need to count on a depth of 4¾".






## **SKYTTA stop bar**

### Frame your doors with a stop bar


A stop bar is a good way of creating a frame around your sliding doors, as well as providing an extra protection for the wall. It can be placed above the skirting board or fitted inbetween as the illustration shows.

Don't forget to measure the thickness of your skirting board, as that can differ from style and brand.

Our SKYTTA stop bar is available in white and comes in two widths to match the rails. It's  $\frac{3}{4}$ " thick and  $94\frac{1}{2}$ " high with the possibility to cut to desired height.




Cut the skirting board and crown molding so that the stop bar fits between the floor and ceiling. The stop bar could be placed above the skirting board, in wich case you need to measure the skirting board as the thickness vary from brand and style.



It's possible to use the doors without the SKYTTA stop bar as shown in this illustration or use a customised solution. Keep in mind that walls can be slightly uneven if you let the doors run against the wall, which can cause gaps.

# How to build with ceiling height reducer



Is your ceiling higher than the SKYTTA sliding doors? No worries. The ceiling height reducer will help you bridge the gap. Use them above your doors and complete with cover panels that you paint to match.

This ceiling height reducer can be mounted above the SKYTTA sliding doors, to bridge the gap if your ceiling height is up to 14%" higher than the doors.

Complete the ceiling height reducer with SKYTTA cover panel on each side and paint it to match your room. Or use pre-treated cover panels from our kitchen range, available in a variety of colors
